Meeting was called to order at 1:00 pm by President Adette Irish.

Announcements:

1. President Adette Irish announced that the GNBAC Fall Festival is October 26. We will have a table in the Faust Brewery on Castell Street. We will sell the plates, trays and other wooden items that have been painted for the fundraiser. Pricing is \$20., \$30., \$40. Each artist will determine the price for their item. Adette Irish, Debbie Howard and Liz Tashakori will man the table.
2. CLAG will be represented at a 10'x10' area in the GNBAC December 6 First Friday. It will be in the NBU parking lot on the Square. There will be Caroling in the Square and many other activities. Diane Parker and Lisa Jarman will be Co-chairs of the event.
3. The CLAG Christmas Party will be on Dec. 11. CLAG usually provides the meat for the meal (\$150.) but considering the tragedies of the recent hurricanes, CLAG will donate \$150. to Samaritan's Purse. We will also collect donations at the Christmas party to be added to that donation. It will be a Pot Luck Luncheon (including membership's delicious meat dishes) and we will play games (TBD). Nominations for the 2025 Executive Board and standing committees will be announced Dec. 11.
4. Friends of TPML will be holding Taste and Talent on February 22, 2025. Diane Schaule will chair this event and Marilyn Good will chair the Silent Auction that day. CLAG and The Friends of the TPML will split the monies from the silent auction 50/50.
5. Liz Tashakori said it is time to sign up for Lasting Impressions Show. Sign up sheet went around.
6. Sandra Brenkis stated that it would be nice to have several members sign up for Hospitality. They would help serve and clean up.
7. Kathy Perales announced that NBAL will have a Jury day on Dec. 6th. More info on the NBAL website. There has been a donation of canvases. Please make a donation and take what you need.
8. There were 45 people in attendance today and there were several guests. CLAG's newest member, Sue Jordan, won Split the Pot. Other new members were Rebecca Strasner and Jan Hoobyar. Welcome!!
9. Diane Parker announced the demonstrations....Diane did the demo today. She showed how to make a darling, small, glamorous shell dish. November 13th will be an Artist who will show Echo Prints. A workshop will be available at a later date if there is interest.

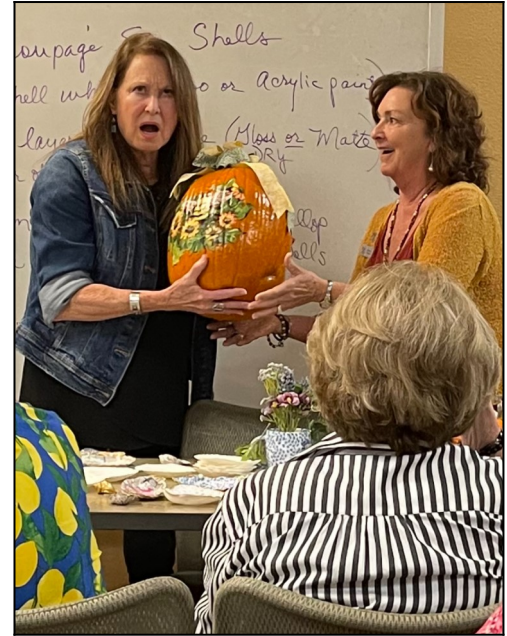

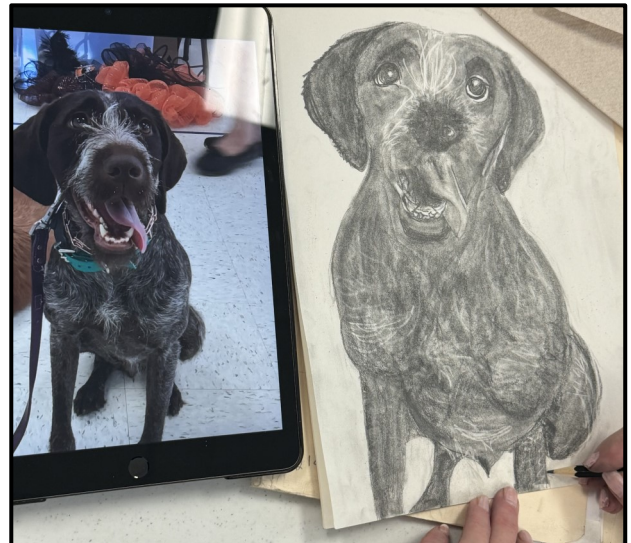

each one in only 30 minutes.

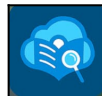

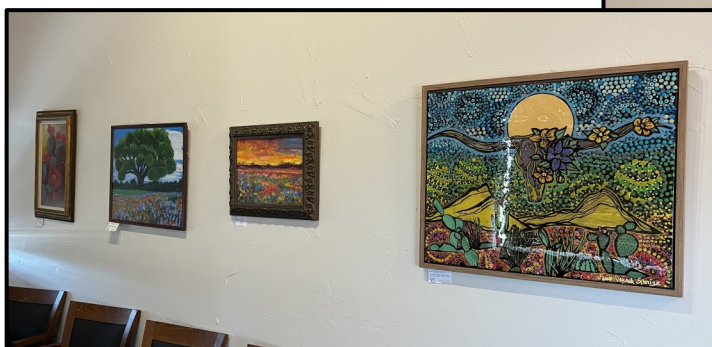

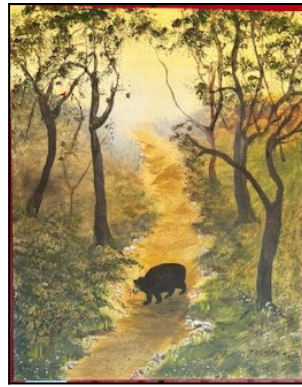

GREEN CHILI STEW
(Chili Verde)

- 1/4 Cup Canola oil (or another high temp oil)
- 2 Lbs. Lean Chuck Roast or Venison Roast (Cut into 1" chunks)
- 1 tsp. Table Salt
- 1 Cup Onions, chopped
- 1 Clove Garlic, minced
- 1/2 tsp. Ground Cumin
- 2 Cups Chopped Tomatoes
- 1 Lg. Can (1 Lb. 10 oz) Green Chilies (chopped)
- 1 Cup Beef Stock or Water



On medium heat, put the oil in medium to large pot and add onions and saute until the onions become opaque. Add the garlic and salt, saute for a few more minutes until you can smell the garlic. Add the meat and cook till brown. Add the beef stock (or water), tomatoes and green chilies and simmer about 2 hours. Taste and adjust seasoning as needed. Serve over beans, rice, potatoes, toast or noodles or corn chips.

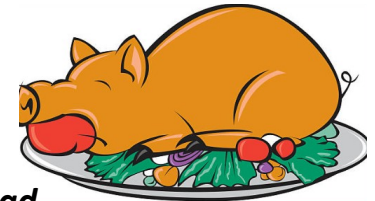
